• bachelors degree:

an undergraduate course which usually lasts 3-4 years 학사 학위

• boarding school:

a school where pupils live during term time 기숙학교

• distance learning:

a way of studying where tuition is carried out over the Internet or by post 원거리 교육(ex. 온라인 클라스)

• face-to-face classes:

as opposed to distance learning the traditional way of studying in a classroom with colleagues and a teacher 대면 수업

• to fall behind with your studies:

to progress less quickly than others 남들보다 (진도나 성적이) 뒤쳐지다

• to give feedback:

to offer guidance on a student's work 피드백을 주다

• a graduation ceremony:

an event where a successful student receives his or her academic degree 졸업식

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• higher education:

education, usually in a college or university, that is followed after high school or secondary school

• an intensive course:

a course that offers lots of training in order to reach a goal in as short a time as possible 인텐시브 코스

- to keep up with your studies: to not fall behind 공부를 계속하다(진도를 따라잡다)

• a mature student:

a student who is older than average and who has usually returned to education after a period at work 나이 많은 학부생

• masters degree:

a period of study which often follows the completion of a bachelors degree or is undertaken by someone regarded as capable of a higher-level academic course 석사 학위

• to meet a deadline:

to finish a job or task in the time allowed or agreed 제출일등에 맞춰서 일을 하다

• to play truant:

to stay away from classes without permission

• private language school:

an independent school run as a business concern 사설 영어 학교

• public schools:

exclusive independent schools in the UK 공립 학교

• a single-sex school:

a school where only boys or girls attend (as opposed to a mixed-sex school) 여학교 / 남학교

• to sit an exam:

to take an exam 시험을 보다

• state school:

a school paid for by public funds and available to the general public 주립 학교

• subject specialist:

a teacher who has a great deal of knowledge about the subject they teach. 과목 전문가

• to take a year out:

to spend a year working or travelling before starting university 대입 전에 1년 쉬면서 일이나 공부하는 것

• tuition fees:

the money paid for a course of study 수업료

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• to work your way through university:

to have a paid job whilst studying to support yourself financially 학비 벌면서 공부하다
